The race begins, appropriately enough, at Koenig Field House near Race Street. It proceeds down Greendale, then follows New, West Swissvale, Pennwood, under the underpass on Race, East Swissvale, Oakview, Chestnut, Elm, Linden, Maple, Beech, Locust, Hawthorn, Walnut, East

Swissvale, Race, Pennwood, Little Race, and back to Greendale. These streets will be closed from approximately 8:15-10 a.m. For a complete map of the course, visit the borough website.

The parade begins at 11 a.m. at the top of Maple and takes a fairly direct route to the field.

If you live along either of these routes, be aware that your street will be closed for some portion of the morning, and plan ahead if you need to get your car out.



I hope everyone will come out for Community Day on Saturday, August 18. The fireworks show will likely be the most up close display you will ever see.

Comprehensive Planning Process

The borough is in the midst of several initiatives that will have long-term effects on the borough. Our comprehensive plan is moving forward. Our public meeting in May, seeking community input, attracted almost 80 residents. We are in the midst of selecting a professional planning firm that will assist in the planning and improvement of Edgewood Avenue. The goal is not only the physical improvements themselves, but to formulate a plan that will impact the future of Edgewood Avenue, Edgewood Towne Center, and the borough owned "parcel D" adjacent to Edgewood Towne Center.

Code Enforcement Initiative

The final initiative began in early July. The borough is serious about maintaining the quality of our community. The borough's ability to maintain itself as a desirable place to live begins with maintaining the value of our community. While this argument can center on public safety or tax burden I believe that its most fundamental component is the quality of our housing stock

and specifically our code enforcement efforts. The borough has begun going street by street inspecting properties. We will work our way through every street, past every property in the borough. We will issue warning letters, allow time for improvements to be made, but issue citations and take property owners before the magistrate if necessary.

These inspections will focus on every aspect of a property that falls under our property maintenance code. This includes curbs, sidewalks, grass and shrubs, as well as those aspects of a property visible from the street. We will be fair, but apply the same standards throughout every street on every property in the borough. For those of you who have complained about specific properties, please by patient. The citation system provides a generous amount of time to offenders, and the system often allows tremendous leeway to those inclined to not take care of their property.

Oftentimes, as many of you are aware, questionable activity often centers around neglected or abandoned properties. We can allow neither of those to continue in this borough. Dilapidated properties have a tendency to not stay isolated. In those areas of town where those properties have appeared we will stay focused in eliminating them. Property owners will be responsible for maintaining their properties or be answerable for their neglect. I will continue to report on our efforts.

Activity Report

The Edgewood Police Department responded to and handled 2,636 calls for service in May 2007. There were 831 incidents reported, 371 complaints received and 13 accidents investigated, one of which resulted in personal injury, and 11 of which resulted in property damage.

Part I Crimes are the more serious crimes of homicide, rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny, motor vehicle theft and arson. Of the 19 Part I Crimes committed in the borough, there were no robberies, one motor vehicle theft, 13 shoplifting incidents, one aggravated assault, and three other crimes.

There were 20 adult and one juvenile arrests made for felony and misdemeanor violations.

Edgewood officers wrote a total of 176 traffic citations, 365 parking citations and three arrests for driving under the influence were made. There were three vandalism/criminal mischief complaints and no narcotics offenses.

Officers also responded to 16 false alarm calls, took 499 reports, responded
