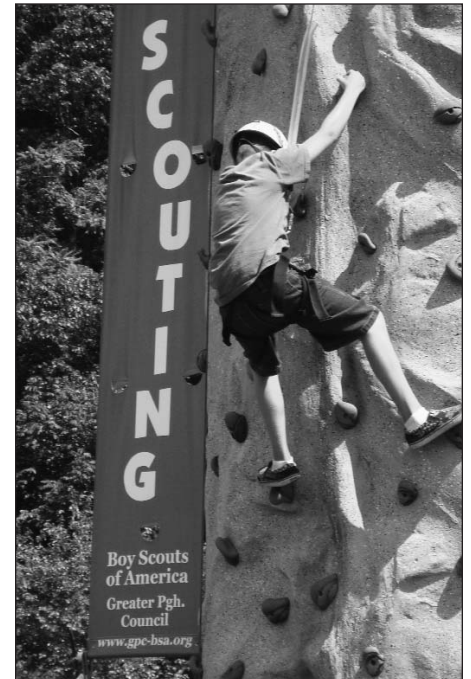

## Library

### Wise Walk is Back

This summer 20 adults and children signed up for the library's 10-week walking program. These walkers accomplished 11,898,996 steps which equals 3,386 miles. We are ready to start again in September. Participants in Wise Walk keep track of their steps using a pedometer supplied by the library. The first fifteen new walkers will also receive a t-shirt.

Each week walkers report their steps to the library. Participants can do the program totally on their own or meet fellow walkers at the library for a 45-minute walk around the borough on Tuesdays at 9 a.m. beginning September 9. Stop into the library to register and to pick up your pedometer and t-shirt. This program is offered in cooperation with the Allegheny County Library Association, Highmark PALS program and AARP.

### Fashion Show and Tea

The celebration of the library's 90th birthday continues with a fashion show narrated by Jean Kanouff on Saturday, September 13 at 1 p.m. in the library. The fashions will center on 1918, the year the library opened. Jean will show dresses and accessories from her collection. She will feature items from the World War I era as well as the

## July 2008 Activity Report

The Edgewood Police Department responded to and handled 1,433 calls for service in July 2008. There were 434 incidents reported, 188 complaints received and 10 accidents investigated, of which two resulted in personal injury, and eight resulted in property damage.

Part I Crimes are the more serious crimes of homicide, rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny, motor vehicle theft and arson. Of the 29 Part I Crimes committed in the borough, there were one burglary, 20 shoplifting incidents, and eight other crimes.

There were 11 adult and one juvenile arrests made for felony and misdemeanor violations.

Edgewood officers wrote a total of 51 traffic citations, 266 parking cita-

tions and made one arrest for driving under the influence. There were four vandalism/criminal mischief complaints and three narcotics offenses.

Officers also responded to 16 false alarm calls, took 246 reports, responded to 28 public nuisance complaints, wrote five non-traffic citations and responded to 12 calls for medical assistance.
