§ 89-1. Definitions.

As used in this chapter, the term "bicycle" shall have the same meaning as "pedalcycle" as defined in the Vehicle Code, 75 Pa.C.S.A. § 102.

§ 89-2. Driving on sidewalks.

The operation of bicycles on sidewalks shall be regulated as set forth in 75 Pa.C.S.A. § 3508.

§ 89-3. Safe operation.

All persons shall operate their bicycles in a safe manner, in accordance with 75 Pa.C.S.A. §§ 3504, 3505 and 3506.

§ 89-4. Compliance with state provisions.

All other provisions of the Vehicle Code applicable to bicycles and pedalcycles, as set forth in 75 Pa.C.S.A. § 3501 et seq., shall be controlling within the Borough.

§ 89-5. Violations and penalties.

Any person who shall violate any provision of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced as set forth in 75 Pa.C.S.A. § 3502.
