### BOROUGH OF EDGEWOOD MINUTES OF THE COUNCIL MEETING HELD JUNE 2, 2014

President Schaefer called the meeting of the Borough of Edgewood to order at 7:35 pm in the Municipal Building.

#### **ROLL CALL**

Upon roll call, the following responded: Mr. Bright, Dr. Wallace, Mr. Wainright, Mr. Wilson, Dr. Petrolla and Ms. Schaefer.

Mayor Cook and Solicitor Barry were also present.

#### **PLEDGE**

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

#### **AUTHORIZATION TO PAY BILLS**

Mr. Wainright moved to authorize the payment of bills, for goods and services received by the Borough, having been reviewed and approved by the General Government Committee, in the amount of \$111,845.13 from the General Fund and \$1,153.50 from the Sewer Fund for a total of \$112,998.63. Second by Dr. Wallace.

DISCUSSION: None.

Upon roll call vote the following responded yes: Mr. Bright, Dr. Wallace, Mr. Wainright, Mr. Wilson, Dr. Petrolla and Ms. Schaefer. **Motion carried**.

#### **BUSINESS MEETING**

VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT Mr. Reynolds said the Fire Department was now on Twitter and Facebook, and that they had recently updated their website. He said the department was interested in spending grant money to update the Borough's front sign, and also asked for a washer and dryer to be installed for the live-in program.

RECREATION REPORT Ms. Bastianini said T-ball and softball practices began, and that the ribbon cutting ceremony for the playground will take place Saturday, June 7th from 11 am-1 pm at Koenig Field. She said Movies in the Park will begin June 9th at dusk.

WATER AUTHORITY REPORT There was no report.

PLANNING COMMISSION Mayor Cook had nothing to report.

**COG REPORT** Mr. Wilson said the COG discussed land banking, and renting out the vactor truck and other equipment.

<u>SOLICITOR'S REPORT</u> Solicitor Barry said he had two issues to discuss in Executive Session involving potential litigation.

BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT Ms. Bastianini said sewer spot lining will occur this week, and that the road paving bid documents were being finalized. She said the Borough received a final copy of the S. Braddock Avenue Road Safety Audit, and that she and Mr. Cecconi would review and provide recommendations to Council.

NEW BUSINESS Ms. Schaefer said on Tuesday, June 17th, 3 Rivers Wet Weather will be hosting an EPA Municipal Update. Mayor Cook said a Volunteer Recruitment event will take place June 14th at the C. C. Mellor Library from 1-4 PM. Dr. Petrolla said D's Six Pax and Dogz agreed to host a beer garden during Community Day.
