**RECREATION REPORT** Ms. Bastianini thanked Council for a successful Community Day. She said soccer practices were underway with 151 kids signed up for the league.

<u>WATER AUTHORITY REPORT</u> Mr. Fuller said there were a very large number of water line breaks this summer. The authority is looking into customer bill pay over the phone, and the service would add \$2.50-\$3.00 onto the cost of the bill. He said that the water line on McKelvey Avenue would be replaced next year.

PLANNING COMMISSION Mayor Cook said the commission did not meet.

**COG REPORT** The COG is accepting applications for CDBG funds, and the Borough will submit an application for handicap curb ramps.

**SOLICITOR'S REPORT** Solicitor Barry said he distributed a memo to Council on Parcel D.

**BOROUGH MANAGER'S REPORT** Ms. Bastianini said the 2017 Minimum Municipal Pension Obligation would be \$159,480. She said construction was underway on the salt storage facility, and she be completed by October 1st.

She also said she was receiving quotes for reconstruction of Mifflin Ave., as part of the roadway is eroding over the hillside.
